Faith Like A Mustard Seed

Matthew tells the story of a Canaanite woman whose daughter was demon-possessed and suffering greatly (15:21-28). She made a request of Jesus, but until she displayed "great faith", Jesus did not help her. This woman and her daughter were not Jewish and were not part of the people Jesus was sent to help (v. 24). Yet through her persistence and a demonstration of faith, Jesus healed her daughter.

The Canaanite woman came to Jesus humbly, asking for help because she had heard what Jesus could do. We don't know if she witnessed Jesus healing someone or if she simply heard about Him and believed He could help her daughter. Her faith allowed her to kneel in front of a great teacher and beg for help.

The Canaanite people had no political or religious power at the time, and most would never think about going up to a Jew and asking for help. When our own power is weak and we have no place else to turn where does our faith lead us? Let your "great faith" lead you to humbly bow before your Lord and receive the blessing He has for you.

Maybe your faith represents the size of your God. If you don't see God as the all-powerful and all-knowing God who created the universe simply by speaking, then you may not see Him as able to help you with your problem. Only when we make God totally Lord of our lives can we develop and demonstrate the "great faith" of the Canaanite woman.

The last thought I had about this story is that our faith must be a "great faith" even when things are going well. We can't be part-time faithful, we must be faithful until death.

Faith out.
